The effect of Stellate Ganglion Block on hemodynamic intraoperative and postoperative complications of Laparoscopic Surgery in women

Protocol summary

Summary

Objective: Hemodynamic changes are a major cause of concern in laparoscopic surgery. Design and Participants: In this study 60 patients, intraoperative hemodynamic effect of satellite ganglion block and complications after laparoscopic surgery for women is investigated. Intervention: Fifteen minutes before induction of anesthesia and involves an ultrasound exam with 10 mL of lidocaine 1% in the intervention group satellite ganglion block and control group are also listed conditions will receive 10 cc distilled water as placebo. Induction of anesthesia, care and monitoring of patients perform by second doctor who is blinded to groups. Main outcome: All hemodynamic parameters such as blood pressure, heart rate, especially in periods after intubation, during and after blowing a CO2 gas switching positions (Trendelenburg) is recorded. After the surgery, the postoperative pain using the NRS criteria will be measured.
