Comparison of intravenous Acetaminophen, Diclofenac suppository and Acetaminophen suppository in febrile hospitalized children

Protocol summary

Summary

This study is designed to compare the antipyretic effectiveness of intravenous and rectal Acetaminophen and rectal Diclofenac in febrile children. Through this randomized controlled trial, 120 patients aged between 1 and 6 years with rectal fever more than 38° Celsius refer to Beheshti Hospital of Kashan, Iran will be studied. Inclusion criteria included: Children aged 1 to 6 years admitted in Beheshti Hospital with rectal temperature over 38 degrees. Exclusion criteria included: The use of anti pyretic drug before admission; diarrhea; drug intolerance; using techniques such as sponge. The patients will be randomly assigned into one of three groups. First group (N= 40 cases) will receive 15 mg/kg Acetaminophen rectally and the second group (N= 40 cases) will receive 10 mg/kg Acetaminophen (IV) and the third group (N= 40 cases) will receive 1 mg/kg Diclofenac rectally. Then, the body temperature will be assessed at the end of the first hour and will be compared between three groups.
