Comparison of proximal radial artery to brachial artery in creation of arteriovenous fistula for hemodialysis

Protocol summary

Summary

Radiocephalic arteriovenous fistula (AVF) at wrist is the vascular access of choice for dialysis. In the absence of a suitable vein at the wrist, a brachiocephalic fistula at elbow is usually constructed. We in this study according to position and excellency of utilization of Proximal Radial Artery, we in this study 124 patient who candidate for creation of arteriovenous fistula in the antecubital region divided in two groups, and in one group use brachial artery and in another group use proximal radial artery then compare this two arteries in creation of vascular access for dialysis according to incidence of primary failure, complication and time of maturation.
