Evaluation of topical lidocaine efficacy on respiratory complications after laryngeal mask airway insertion

Protocol summary

Summary

Sore throat is one of the most common complications of general anesthesia. The source of pain may be from pharyngeal, laryngeal or tracheal and may be the cause of unpleasantness, discomfort and a bad memory after general anesthesia. This study considers evaluating the effectiveness of lidocaine gel on the sore throat, cough and scratchy throat after insertion of a laryngeal mask airway. Sixty patients who scheduled for elective eye surgery under general anesthesia and with criteria for inclusion in the study were randomly divided into two groups of intervention and control in one blind study. The posterior surface of LMAs was lubricated with lidocaine gel 2% in the intervention group and non-medical lubricant gel in the control group was used. After induction of anesthesia that was similar in all patients, the LMA was inserted using classical method by an anesthesiologist who was unaware of the gel that was used, and after ensuring adequate ventilation was fixed in place. Twenty-four hours after the operation the patient's sore throat, coughing and itchy throat were checked
