An Investigation into the Efficacy of Intra-articular Injection of Botulinum Toxin versus Steroid on Pain and Function of Patients with Knee Osteoarthritis

Protocol summary

Summary

Objectives: The aim of this study is to compare efficacy and safety of intra articular injection of Botulinum toxin versus steroid (triamcinolone acetonide) in patients with knee OA. **Study Design:** Double blind Randomized controlled clinical trial. **Setting and Conduct:** In this study a total of 40 patients with more than three months of chronic pain in the knee joints along with consistent imaging findings (Kellgren-Lawrence score of II&III) would be enrolled and randomly allocated into two groups of Botulinum toxin and steroid. **Participants:** Patients suffering from mild to moderate knee OA referred to Shahid Modarres Hospital of Saadat Abad in Tehran in 2016. **Interventions:** a single injection of Botulinum toxin, Dysport® (half of a 500-IU vial) in one group and a single vial of 40 mg/ml triamcinolone acetonide in other group. **Outcome measures:** Patients would be evaluated at baseline and 8 & 24 weeks after injection for pain, stiffness and function using the Visual Analog Scale (VAS) and the Western Ontario and McMaster Universities Arthritis Index (WOMAC) questionnaire.

Inclusion/Exclusion criteria

Inclusion criteria: Confirmed knee-osteoarthritis patients

based on American College of Rheumatology (ACR) criteria with ages ranging from 40 to 75 years; more than 3 months symptoms resistant despite the conservative treatment; grade 2 or 3 according to KLS system in plain x-ray film. Exclusion criteria: Infection and active wound in knee; Gout or psudogout; neuromuscular illnesses; Pregnancy or breast-feeding; any history of intra articular injection over the past 3 months; Acute trauma of knee; Recent physiotherapy during last 3 months; Genuvarum or valgum more than 20 degrees; Radioculophathy; BMI $\geq$ 35; Hx of allergy to Botulinium Toxin; Systemic illnesses like diabetes melitus, immunodeficiency, and vascular collagen diseaes; prior history of cancer or active malignant lesions; ages below 40 years or above 75 years.
