Effect of adjunctive nebulized magnesium sulfate on symptoms and lung volumes, in patients presenting with acute exacerbation of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease

Protocol summary

Summary

1. Objectives: Acute exacerbation is a fact during natural course of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and the optimal treatments are still subject of ongoing researches. In this study we want to investigate the short term, in-hospital outcome of nebulized Magnesium sulfate in the terms of subjective and objective improvement in acute COPD exacerbation. 2. Design: Patients presented with acute COPD exacerbation will be randomly assigned (using random number table) to group-A and group-B. In addition to standard treatment, Group-A patients will receive Magnesium Sulfate by nebulizer mask and group-B will receive placebo. 3. Setting and conduct: Both group of patient will receive drug or placebo in similar container just before diagnostic tests. In addition to patients, researcher (who gathers the data) will not be aware of drug/placebo group. 4. Participants including major eligibility criteria: patients with known history of COPD presenting to emergency department with acute disease exacerbation will be included. Those with other associated medical disorders and unstable/uncooperative patients will be excluded. 5. Intervention: In addition to standard treatment, patients in drug / placebo group will receive 2.5 cc Magnesium Sulfate Vial 20% (Manufactured by Pasteur institute, IRC code: 1228054884) by nebulizer mask or 2.5 cc Sodium Chloride 0.9% (manufactured by Samen co. IRC code:1228065256) respectively. 6. Main outcome measures (variables): just before taking drug/placebo and again 90 minutes after that, the following variables will be checked: Lung volumes, Arterial oxygen saturation of hemoglobin and Persian version of CAT questionnaire.

Inclusion criteria: 1. Known history of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) based on previous clinical history and spirometry; 2. Presenting to emergency department with at least two of following symptoms: shortness of breath, increase in the amount of sputum and/or purulent pattern of the sputum; 3. Age > 40 years; 4. within 24 h of hospital admission; 5. smoking history > 20 pack.year; Exclusion Criteria: 1. Patient with unstable vital signs; 2. Intubated patient; 3. Associated comorbidity (pneumothorax, pulmonary embolism, pneumonia, acute coronary syndrome, congestive heart failure, neuromuscular disease, active malignancy and etc.); 4. Unconscious patient; 5. Inability to perform spirometry; 6. Nursing/pregnant women; 7. Previous history of allergy to magnesium sulfate;
