A comparison of therapeutic effects of teicoplanin versus vancomycin in patients admitted to the Intensive Care Unit after cardiac surgery because of MRSA infectious endocarditis in Masih Daneshvari hospital between years 2012-2016

Protocol summary

Summary

This study intends to investigate the therapeutic effects of two drugs Vancomycin and Teicoplanin in clinical trial in patients hospitalized in intensive care after surgery for endocarditis infections caused by strains of methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus. This study was done on 46 operated patient by surgery complications in infective endocarditis caused by strains of methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus organisms. Patients with Prohibition of use for each of these two drugs were excluded from the study. This study was conducted as a double blind study which neither the patients, the experimenter were not aware of type of intervention. Randomized block design was used to random allocation of patients to two groups. Teicoplanin was used by intravenous and intramuscular injection and single dose daily. Initial Vancomycin dose was 1500 mg every 12 hours until serum concentration monitoring indicates the need for higher dosing. After two months Culture and isolation was compared in tow groups.
