Comparison of second degree burns healing time in two methods of dressing by Sea buckthorn herbal ointment and %1 Silver sulfadiazine ointment in Imam Mousa Kazem hospital 2015

Summary

This study performed to assess and compare 2 degree burn's healing time in two methods of dressing by sea buckthorn herbal ointment and %1 Silver sulfadiazine ointment in 60 patients of Imam Mousa Kazem hospital in Isfahan. The patients, aged 18-60 years old, with burning wounds area between 1-10% of body surface were randomly assigned into intervention or control group to receive wound dressing with sea buckthorn or Silver Sulfadiazine 1%, daily, until complete wound healing. The time to healing will be measured and compared between groups.

Inclusion criteria: 1-age 18-60 years old 2- burn only in contact with heat resource or hot fluids 3- burn area between 1- 10% 4-less than 6 hours passed from burning occurrence 5-patients with second degree burn 6- the wounds without any infection or trauma 7- burn only on body and/or extremities and not on head,neck and genital area Exclusion criteria: 1- burn wound damage during care 2- presence of underlying diseases such as anemia, diabetes, cardiovascular disease, malignancy

and immune insufficiency;; need to consumption of immune supportive drugs; corticosteroids or chemotherapy 3- pregnancy 4- failure to cooperation.
