The effect of Rosuvastatin on clinical and electrodiagnostic findings in patients with Carpal Tunnel Syndrome

Protocol summary

Summary

Carpal Tunnel Syndrome (CTS) is the most common mediastinal neuropathy that is caused by the pressure of the median nerve under the transverse wrist ligament. In this study, we investigated the effect of rosuvastatin on clinical signs and electrodeaganoind findings in patients with mild to moderate CTS. The present study is an interventional study (RCT). The study population included all patients with mild to moderate degrees of CTS. From among the patients referring to the study, 50 subjects were selected by available sampling and randomly assigned 25 patients in the treatment group with resoastatin and 25 in the control group (gol drug treatment). The study is done blindly. According to the random numbers table, they are divided into test and control groups. We will give Rosvothactine to one of the groups and another drug group. After taking the biography and conducting the examination, according to the findings of electrodeagnosis, they are in the mild and moderate group. The division of patients into these two groups according to the degree of median nerve function disorder is based on the findings of electrodeagnosis of the nerve damage. In the test group, a dose of 20 mg once daily is given as a rosuvastatin tablet and a daily dose of one tablet of placebo for one month. Data were collected using Boston Questionnaire, Visual Analogue Benchmarking (VAS), and Electrodiogenic Findings (EDX). Patients with clinical signs and electrodiagnostic CTS with mild to moderate intensity entered the study and patients who had previous history of statin use, history of previous surgery for CTS, severe CTS patients with muscle atrophy, severe statin allergy out of study To be
