Comparative study of topical TCA %50 and cultured autologous fibroblasts in the treatment of the atrophic scars of face. (Pilot Study)

Protocol summary

Summary

The purpose of this pilot study is to compare efficacy and side effects of injection of living autologous fibroblast versus TCA 50% for the treatment of atrophic facial scar. The study Population consists of patients with facial contour deformities including acne scars or leishmaniasis scar. A total of 20 patients are randomly assigned into two groups. In one group, the patients receive 3 doses of living autologous fibroblast (20 million/ml) at two weeks interval. In another group, the patients receive 3 times treatment of topical TCA 50%. TCA 50% was applied once monthly for 3 months. Efficacy evaluations are performed every 2 weeks until three months and then 6 and 12 months after the first treatment. The size of scar, patient's satisfaction, and side effects are recorded in each visit.
