The Impact of Spiritual Care on anxiety and spiritual health of mothers of premature infant in Neonatal Intensive Care Unit

Protocol summary

Study aim

Comparing the Anxiety and Spiritual Health of mothers before and after the implementation of the spiritual care program for the mothers of newborn in neonatal intensive care unit

Design

In this research, 66 mothers of premature infants who were enrolled in the intensive care unit were selected and non-random divided into intervention and control groups, each assigned a code.

Settings and conduct

The researcher referred to the medical and therapeutic center of Ommlbanin Hospital during the 9 to 15 hours of sampling. After selecting mothers, the necessary explanations about the research and the research goals are given to each mother in the neonatal intensive care unit in accordance with the need and knowledge level of the mother in face-to-face form. If you would like to participate in the study, you will be informed in writing and the questionnaires will be completed. At the time of discharge, the questionnaires will be completed for both groups

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

inclusion criteria: Mothers of premature infants hospitalized; At the start of the study, at least one day and a maximum of one week from the time the infant is admitted; Do not use drugs (or any psychoactive substances such as cigarettes, opium, glass, hashish, heroin, cocaine). exclusion criteria: Participate in spiritual care classes; Have a history of mental illness According to family; More than one week after admission of the infant.

Intervention groups

In the intervention group, according to the needs assessment, the spiritual care included: protectionist presence (the presence of a researcher alongside mothers, verbal and non verbal communication, active listening and answering the questions of mothers and explaining the course of the disease of the infant),

support for religious ceremonies Family (Providing the necessary facilities for worship such as Mehr and Sajjad, prayers and tents of prayer, Quran, Motifah, Quranic software and supplication), the use of supportive systems (spiritual presence and counseling, the presence of family along with the baby when Taking remedial measures and establishing the possibility of a farewell to the infant), will be presented. In the control group, the usual treatment and routine supportive system will be implemented.

Description

Intervention group: According to the needs assessment and interview with the mothers, audiobooks, educational books, and worship objects will be placed in a dressing room designed for relaxation and, in accordance with the mother's request, the materials provided by the researcher through the telegram, CD, Flash and mobile transfer will be provided to the mother. The posters for space maternity and maternity rooms will be provided. The 9 spiritual actions proposed in this study included: Spiritual Action 1: Facilitate spiritual care including prayer ceremony and facilitate the organization of religious ceremonies appropriate to the culture and the family. Spiritual Action 2: Spiritual protection involves providing worship objects and encouraging participation in ceremonies. Spiritual Action 3: Presence includes physical presence and availability. Spiritual Action 4: Active listening involves listening without judgments to mothers' speeches, providing memos to moms for writing and expressing their concerns and religious care. Spiritual Action 5: Goodness and goodwill, including familiarizing the staff with spiritual care and how to deal with mothers. Spiritual Action 6: Touch involves hugging mother and baby with the parent's permission and facilitating and encouraging the presence of the father alongside the mother and helping to establish Correct relationship with the baby. Spiritual Action 7: Increasing self-awareness involves increasing knowledge about how to care for the baby with CDs and educational books and raising awareness about the course of the baby's disease. Spiritual Action 8: Voice Therapy featuring indifferent music and religious sound therapy. Spiritual Action 9: Instilling hope, including the beauty of the section and placing the contents of the hope and tranquility of the room of the mothers based on the requirements of the needs assessment. The intervention group of your choice and as required in the need assessment stage, one or more cases They will receive the mentioned spiritual care in their approved forms.
