Impact of spiritual care on the hope and spiritual well-being of cancer patients

Protocol summary

Study aim

Determine the effect of spiritual care on the hope and spiritual well-being of cancer patients

Design

This study is a clinical trial that has control and intervention group and will be done without blinding. Participants fall into the groups by block random allocation. The number of samples, with a drop of 10%, is projected to be 88. After the formation of the groups, the intervention of the spiritual care will be carried out in accordance with the Bussing protocol. The data were collected through two questionnaires of hope and a questionnaire of Pulotzin and Ellison, and data analysis was done using SPSS version 21.

Settings and conduct

The way of spiritual care intervention is based on the Bussing et al. (2010) protocol in four main religious areas (Excellence), being (meaning and purpose), emotional (relaxation) and social (communication) in 5 sessions, 2 hours before starting chemotherapy in the department. Will be executed by the project executives. The duration of each session varied between 45 and 60 minutes. The location of the study is Shahid Rajaee Hospital in Yasuj

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

The population of this study is cancer patients referred to the chemo department of the Shahid Rajaie Hospital in Yasuj in 1396-97. The criteria for entering the study include a definitive diagnosis of cancer by the oncologist, chemotherapy, age range of 20 to 60 years, the patient's knowledge of his diagnosis, the absence of known psychological and mental disorders other than cancer, obtaining a low level score Spiritual well being (20-40) and hope score less than 32 are willing to participate in the study consciously. The reluctance of the company, the criticality of the patient's clinical condition so that they are unable to attend the intervention sessions and the patient's death will be the exit from the study.

Intervention groups

The intervention group is a group that includes cancer

patients undergoing chemotherapy for which spiritual care is provided.
