A comparative study of the effect of the educational intervention based on positive psychology and exercise on depression anxiety and stress on students with premenstrual syndrome

Protocol summary

Study aim

A comparative study of the effect of the educational intervention based on positive psychology and exercise on depression anxiety and stress on students with premenstrual syndrome

Design

This study is a blinded clinical trial. The study population includes all students of girls' dormitories of Kermanshah University of medical sciences. 120 eligible students will be selected conveniently and randomly will be assigned to four groups (three intervention groups, one control group).

Settings and conduct

This study, which will be conducted in girls' dormitories of Kermanshah University of Medical Sciences, is one blinded one that the statistical analyst is unaware of the allocation of study groups (experimental and control). The samples will be divided into four groups randomly

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Inclusion criteria: Regular menstruation; The length of the menstrual cycle between 22-35 days; The number of menstrual bleeding days between 8-3 days; The grade higher than 18 on premenstrual symptoms questionnaire
Exclusion criteria: A history of ovarian cysts or women's surgery; PMDD diagnosis

Intervention groups

The first intervention group will receive eight sessions of positive psychological intervention for 70 to 90 minutes per week. In the second intervention group, the regular exercise program will be performed three days a week, for 20-30 minutes and 8 weeks, including 5 minutes of warm-up body movements at the beginning of the program, 10-15 minutes soft running with rest intervals and at the end of the time, stretching and relaxing movements will be performed for 5 minutes to cool the body. The third intervention group will receive both interventions include sports activities and educational

intervention based on positive psychology for eight weeks. The control group will not receive any intervention.
