Comparison of the impact of traditional occupational therapy and commercially available active video games on improving motor skills and sustained attention and response times in children with developmental coordination disorder

Protocol summary

Motor skills, sustained attention

Study aim

Comparison of the impact of traditional occupational therapy and active video games on motor skills and sustained attention in children with developmental coordination disorder(DCD)

Design

double blind randomized clinical trial with parallel groups design of 20 children with Developmental Coordination Disorder aged 6-9 years old.

Settings and conduct

The present study will be carried out in occupational therapy clinic of Neuromuscular Research Center of Semnan University of Medical Sciences. In this study, a video game will be played in the intervention group for 9 weeks, three sessions of 45 minutes each week. In the control group, traditional occupational therapy interventions for 9 weeks, three 45-minute sessions each week, will be performed by a specialist . After the end of treatment sessions, both groups will be tested again for the Bruininks Oseretsky test and continuous performance. The pre-test and post-test scores of the two groups will be compared.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Inclusion criteria of both groups are DCD children with typical IQ and age range from 6 to 9 years. Exclusion criteria are seizure ,orthopedic disorder,visual acuity problems that can not be corrected with glasses and comorbidity with attention deficit and hyper activity disorder.

Intervention groups

The intervention group will play an active video game using Xbox for 27 sessions (3 sessions per 45 minutes each week). The control group will receive traditional occupational therapy interventions for 27 sessions (3 sessions per 45 minutes each week).

In this research, the subjects will be randomly assigned to two groups of intervention and control using card shuffling method. In this way, 20 cards are designed from 1 to 20, and after merging (shuffling), a card is given to each subject, and then the subjects whose number are even will be placed in the intervention group and those who have odd number will be placed in the control group.

Description

Intervention group: In this group, active video games will play for 9 weeks, each week with three 45-minute sessions, under the supervision of therapist. The therapist will try to maintain the child's attention to the process of play, the rules of the game will be communicated to the child by the therapist, all the wrong movements of the child will be corrected and his movements will be encouraged and strengthened.

Description

Control group: In the group of traditional occupational therapy interventions for 9 weeks each week, three 45-minute sessions will be conducted with emphasis on sensory and perceptual integrity approaches by trained occupational therapists. In these sessions, exercises will be aimed at sensory modification, deepening sense, exercise planning exercises, balancing exercises, strengthening subtle movements and enhancing visual and hearing perception. The treatment plan will be based on the assessment results and will be programmed for each child individually.
