Vitamin D for treating autism, a controlled clinical trial

Protocol summary

Summary

This non-randomized 8-week controlled clinical trial examines the effect of vitamin D for treating children with autism and vitamin serum level less than 25ng/ml. There are two groups. Each group includes 15 patients. One group will receive vitamin D. The other group will receive vitamin D plus risperidone. Aberrant Behavior checklist is used to measure the clinical symptoms.
