Comparison of the effectiveness of pharmacotherapy with sertraline versus Glaser reality therapy in social anxiety disorder in medical sciences students

Protocol summary

Study aim

Comparison of the effectiveness of sertraline, glassser reality therapy alone or simultaneously on social anxiety

Design

This study is a quasi-experimental study with pre-test and post-test design. First, 75 students with social anxiety will be selected by convenience sampling method and then will be randomly divided into three groups.

Settings and conduct

It will be performed on medical students with social anxiety in 1400.

In the present study, patients will be divided into three groups. Group 1: Glasser reality therapy II: Glasser reality therapy and sertraline drug Group 3: Sertraline drug therapy

In order to randomize the samples in each group, the subjects are divided into three groups A, B and C using the RAN() function of Excel software, and according to the type of intervention, drug use and participation in mental training classes. It is a treatment, there is no possibility of blindness, there is no intervener and the subjects, and only the statistical analyst does not know what kind of intervention was done by each group.

Intervention group: Venlafaxine treatment will receive sertraline (50 mg daily) for 28 days, after which they will answer the questionnaire questions. In order to evaluate the effect of time on maintaining the effect of the intervention, after two months, the subjects will be asked to answer the research questionnaires again. Finally, the data will be statistically analyzed using spss24 software and multivariate analysis of covariance.

Intervention group: Participate in Glasser reality therapy classes in 8 sessions of 1.5 hours and two sessions per week. At the end of the sessions, all groups will answer the questions of the relevant questionnaire. In order to evaluate the effect of time on maintaining the effect of the intervention, again after two months from the last session, the subjects will be asked to answer the research questionnaires again. Finally, the data will be statistically analyzed using SPSS24 software and multivariate analysis of covariance. Summary of Glasser reality therapy sessions are: introduction and introduction, introduction and purpose of the group and the number of sessions, introduction of members to each other and expressing their expectations of each other, expression of group rules. Completing the pre-test, presenting the homework, reviewing the homework of the previous session, teaching 5 basic needs from

Glasser's point of view and the concept of responsibility and selection, categorizing 5 demands related to the homework of the previous week in these 5 categories by members, submitting homework, reviewing homework of the previous session, Behavior machine training and the effect of thoughts and actions on emotions and bodily changes in the form of behavior machine using members' views, examining social anxiety and examining emotions and bodily changes when social anxiety occurs, presenting homework, reviewing the previous session, teaching the desirable world And the role of desires in creating the desired world and its difference with behavior and basic needs, examining the costs of social anxiety and its importance in life and consulting members about ways to improve it using reality therapy, homework presentation, homework review of the previous session , Give a text to members to present in the meeting and receive feedback, repeat the exercise and review, present the assignment, review the assignment of the previous session, give a long text that requires group cooperation to members to present in the meeting as a group and receive feedback Repeat the exercise and review, present the homework, review the homework of the last session. Investigating the role of excuses in achieving goals. Teaching Seven Destructive Behaviors and Seven Effective Behaviors to Satisfy Needs. Introduction to preparing members for the final session, presenting assignments, reviewing previous session assignments, summarizing, receiving feedback from group members on all sessions, and results in their lives. Final, post-test tagging
