Evaluation of spinal anaesthesia blockade time with 0.5% bupivacaine-with or without sufentanil-in opium addict patients in comparison with non-addicts: a randomized clinical trial

Protocol summary

Summary

With the prevalence of illicit opioid use in different regions around the world, understanding the effect of opium addiction on the clinical practice is becoming a necessity. 60 patients, who are candidate for lower limb surgery, are selected from patients referred to Dr. Shariati hospital and are randomized into 4 groups. Patients with a history of chronic pain or allergies are excluded from the study. Group 1, no history of opium addiction who receive intrathecal bupivacaine along with 1 mL saline as placebo; group 2, no history of opium addiction who receive intrathecal bupivacaine along with 1 mL sufentanil (5 µg); group 3, Positive history of opium addiction who receive intrathecal bupivacaine along with 1 mL saline as placebo; and group 4, positive history of opium addictions who receive intrathecal bupivacaine along with 1 mL sufentanil (5 µg). Onset time and length of sensory and motor blocks are recorded in the 4 groups.
