Effectiveness of respiratory-physical exercises on fatigue and quality of life of nurses caring for COVID-19 patients in the Intensive Care Unit

Protocol summary

Study aim

Determining the effectiveness of respiratory-physical exercises on fatigue and quality of life of nurses caring for COVID-19 patients in the intensive care unit

Design

This is a clinical trial study in which samples are selected by convenience sampling method and then divided into two groups of experimental and control by block randomization method.

Settings and conduct

Study place: Amir Al-Momenin Hospital. Assignment of samples into two groups of intervention and control; then the severity of fatigue and quality of life are measured using the Nurses' Severity of Fatigue Scale and the World Health Organization Quality of Life Questionnaire. Then, the samples in the intervention group are given respiratory-physical movements and exercises in such a way that for 4 weeks and 3 times a week for 35 minutes of respiratory-physical movements and exercises, including: 10 minutes of respiratory exercises, 10 minutes of exercises. Physically and at the end of 15 minutes is Benson's relaxation technique.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

At least 6 months of work experience in the intensive care unit; employed as a nursing team in intensive care units of coronary patients; no participation in yoga and meditation preparation courses; consent to participate in the study; no movement limiting diseases, musculoskeletal disorders, heart and respiratory diseases, neurological and psychiatric diseases. Exclusion criteria: cancellation of study at any stage; not doing exercises less than 2 times a week.

Intervention groups

Intervention: physical breathing exercises in which members of the intervention group perform physical breathing movements twice a week for 35 minutes for 4 weeks. The control group does not do any exercises.

Exclusion criteria:	Withdrawal at any stage Complications of yoga movements Do not do exercises less than 2 times a week

Randomization (investigator's opinion)	Randomized
Randomization description	Simple randomization, research units are divided into two groups of intervention and test using block method by random allocation, so that in terms of age, sex, level of education and work experience in the intensive care unit of patients with Covid 19 are homogeneous. For this purpose, first, according to the variables that need to be homogenized, the class is considered for all possible situations of the research units, and after assigning the code to the nurses, it is placed in the block equivalent to their characteristics. Then, the first person of each block is randomly placed in one of the research groups, and each of the next people of each block, according to the characteristics they have about the variables considered for homogenization, is placed in a group with which people There are fewer features in that group.
