Development and evaluation of the effectiveness of cognitive readiness on stress reactivity, physiological health parameters, optimal decision making and brain wave patterns

Protocol summary

Study aim

develop a cognitive readiness protocol and evaluate its effectiveness on reactivity to stress, physiological health indicators, optimal decision making and brain wave patterns.

Design

Clinical trial with control group, single blind, randomized, on 40 people. The rand function of Excel software was used for randomization

Settings and conduct

Senior military officers who will participate in the three-month period of cognitive readiness improvement plan. This course will be implemented in one of the military centers located in Tehran. Participants will be randomly assigned to two experimental and control groups (probably 20 people in each group). It should be noted that due to the implementation of the research in a military environment and also due to the commitments made to maintain confidentiality, the exact location and some of the demographic characteristics of the participants will not be disclosed.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Entry criteria: 30-40 years old, desire and informed consent to participate in the research Exclusion criteria: presence of mental disorders such as depression, PTST, ASD, tic disorders, anxiety disorders / presence of physical problems and diseases, including history of trauma and Head injury or the presence of brain tumors, severe sweating, skin diseases, especially on the scalp, cardiovascular and respiratory diseases / the presence of disabilities or sensory disorders that affect learning or taking tests, such as visual impairment, hearing problems Difficulty in hand movements, inability or difficulty in standing in a balanced manner

Intervention groups

The experimental group includes people who undergo 72 sessions of cognitive preparation training The control

group includes people who will not receive cognitive training

Main outcome variables

stress reactivity; physiological health parameters; optimal decision making; brain wave patterns

Randomization (investigator's opinion)

Randomization description
People volunteering to participate in the research are randomly assigned to two experimental and control groups. In this regard, a number is assigned to all the people and the people of two groups are determined by drawing lots. In this way, in simple randomization with this method, the numbers related to all sample people are first written on sheets and then placed inside the container; Then, half of the cards are drawn from the container. The removed cards are placed in the experimental group and the remaining cards are placed in the control group. Then, if the two groups were equal in terms of demographic characteristics, the assignment ends, and if not, the above process is repeated until the equality of the two groups is achieved.

Blinding (investigator's opinion)
Double blinded

Blinding description
The participants are fully aware of the research objectives in their group, but they do not know which group they are in (experimental or control) and they are kept unaware of the research objectives in the other

group. Also, A and B codes are sent to the analyst for intervention and control groups so that he does not know about the type of groups. Blinding of the outcome assessor will be ensured by his lack of knowledge about the allocation group of patients.

Physiological health indicators include body mass index (BMI), body fat index (BF), blood serum cholesterol (BSC) and systolic and diastolic blood pressure.

Calculating the ratio of weight to the square of height, the ratio of height and waist circumference per meter, taking 100 cc of blood, digital blood pressure monitor

Description

Optimal decision making using strategic management simulation

Timepoint

1 and 50 days, pre-test and post-test

Method of measurement

Using a computer simulator for 50 minutes and recording scores from reactions and decisions

Description

Recording of brain waves from the QEEG recording device

Timepoint

1 and 50 days, pre-test and post-test

Method of measurement

Recording of four waves of delta, theta, alpha, and beta in 19 regions of the brain

Description

Intervention group: cognitive readiness training during 72 sessions with the headings of cognitive readiness (definition and explanation of cognitive readiness, necessity, goals and expectations, definition of skills, knowledge and insight as the main factors of cognitive readiness), situational awareness (teaching concepts related to three levels of awareness situational awareness, statement of theories of situational awareness, investigation of factors enhancing situational awareness, investigation of factors hindering situational awareness, practical exercises of situational awareness, exercise of assessing situational awareness, exercise of mindfulness with situational awareness). Metacognitive skills (step-by-step training of concepts related to metacognition. Training of cognitive strategies such as summarizing topics, taking notes and practicing retelling of content. Training of planning strategies. Training of monitoring control strategy, techniques for controlling the effectiveness of activities, searching for reasons,

questioning oneself for control. self, training to adjust reaction time to social actions, training strategy including adjustment, modification or change of cognitive and emotional strategy). Problem solving skills (teaching theoretical basics based on the seven-step method). Creative thinking (teaching theoretical concepts, examining the stages of creative thinking, examining the characteristics of creative people, brainstorming technique, lotus blossom technique)
