The effect of family- centered care based on Newman's systemic model on the quality of life in patients with diabetes type 2

Protocol summary

Study aim

Determining the impact of family-centered care based on Betty Newman's systemic model on the quality of life of patients with type 2 diabetes

Design

A randomized controlled clinical trial

Settings and conduct

The research population is all patients with type 2 diabetes referring to Imam Reza (AS) health center in Esfahan city.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Diagnosing type 2 diabetes according to the internist's opinion Having a history of type 2 diabetes for more than one year The ability of the patient to understand and speak Persian Possibility of direct contact with the patient In the critical phase of the disease

Intervention groups

After explaining the objectives of the research and obtaining the research consent, a demographic and quality of life questionnaire was filled out for all patients, and then the Newman evaluation form was completed for them during an interview with all patients in the intervention group. After the data were analyzed, nursing diagnoses based on Nanda It will be determined for patients in the intervention group. In the intervention group, introduce a first-class family member (spouse, parents, children, siblings) who had the most interaction and communication with him. Family-centered care for the intervention group is performed in 2 months, first, the educational needs of the patient with diabetes are determined through the Newman form and based on nursing diagnoses. Then the active member of the family in the intervention group will be trained about diabetes based on the nursing diagnosis. One month after the completion of the training, the quality of life questionnaire will be filled again by the patients of the test and control groups, and the quality of life measured in both the test and control groups before and after the intervention will be compared.

Randomization description

In the first stage, sampling is done in a purpose-based manner, and the eligible samples are selected based on the study entry criteria, then they are randomly assigned to two test and control groups by block method with blocks of 4 people. The simple random method causes the inequality of people in two groups, which reduces the statistical power of the test used. Therefore, by using the block method with random allocation, the people assigned to two groups are equal to each other. To avoid predicting the allocation of people in the group, blocks of different sizes (blocks of 4 people and 6 people) are determined. Then, by entering the information of the number of blocks, groups and total samples to reliable sites such as "https://www.sealedenvelope.com/simple-randomiser/v1/lists", the order of people is assigned to groups, similar to the information below. be.

Intervention groups**1****Description**

Intervention group: The intervention in this study

includes teaching the diet plan of diabetics - teaching the general principles of diabetic foot care - teaching prevention methods - giving awareness and information about the disease - allowing the patient to express his feelings - regular blood sugar control - exercising the feet - Daily walk, regular use of diabetic medication - Regular examination of the skin of the limbs - Recommendation for regular examination by an ophthalmologist - Regular blood sugar control - Training on warning signs and prevention methods - Regular blood pressure control - Training on diet plan for diabetic patients - Previous blood sugar control Sleep-recommendation to exercise before going to sleep-not consuming caffeinated substances before going to sleep-providing a calm environment for sleeping-teaching the patient about the disease and how to control and prevent complications in the form of face-to-face meetings and preparation of educational pamphlets. The sessions are tailored to the educational needs of the patients and are at least 6 sessions of 30 minutes. A meeting will be held every week. The nursing diagnoses related to each patient will be determined based on the completion of the Newman evaluation form by the participating members of the intervention group, and the care plan will be designed and implemented based on the nursing process. that nursing diagnoses based on Nanda Nursing Diagnosis (Nursing Diagnosis Institute of North America) along with related nursing care will be implemented for each patient privately.

Control group: The control group will only complete the quality of life questionnaire and demographic characteristics. The duration of the intervention lasts a maximum of 2 months, and one month after the end of the intervention, the quality of life questionnaire will be completed again.
