Managing Psychological Distress to Improve the Quality of Life, Self-Efficacy and Emotional Intelligence of School Teachers by Using Cognitive Behavioral Therapy

Protocol summary

Study aim

The aim of study is to manage psychological distress to improve quality of life, self-efficacy and emotional intelligence of school teachers by using cognitive behavioral therapy

Design

This phase of the study will be based on Randomized Control Trial with Pre and Post test design with 187 subjects, enrolled between February 2024 to June 2024.

Settings and conduct

The independent variable of the study will be cognitive behavioral therapy while the dependent variable will be psychological distress, quality of life, self-efficacy and emotional intelligence. There will be two groups. One group will be experimental group which will receive treatment and the other will be control group which will not receive any treatment. Nature of the treatment will be brief cognitive behavioral therapy.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Inclusion criteria: Female school teachers employed in government and private schools in the Layyah district, employed for at least one year, females who will score high in psychological distress scale. Exclusion criteria: Male school teachers, who will be unwilling to participate in the CBT intervention, females who will score low in psychological distress scale.

Intervention groups

Participants in the Experimental group will receive 8 sessions of culturally adapted Cognitive behavioral therapy. Each session will be comprised on 120 minutes once in a week. However Control group will be kept passive and will not receive any treatment during experiment.

Main outcome variables

Level of psychological distress.

Method of measurement

The Kessler Psychological Distress Scale (K10) will be used to measure psychological distress. Quality of life by using the WHOQOL-BREF instrument. Self-efficacy will be measured by using Teacher Self-Efficacy Scale (TSES), developed by Schwarzer et al. (1999) and emotional intelligence will be measured by using Brief Emotional Intelligence Scale (BEIS-10).

To assess the impact of psychological distress on quality of life, self-efficacy and emotional intelligence of school teachers

Timepoint

Before the intervention, immediately after the intervention and 6 weeks after the intervention

Psychological distress scale

Intervention groups**1****Description**

Intervention Group: This group will receive Culturally Adopted Cognitive Behavioral Therapy to decrease their

psychological distress and to improve quality of life, self-efficacy and emotional intelligence of school teachers. Culturally adopted cognitive behavior therapy is a dialogue written exercises based therapy that is comprised on eight sessions . All subjects of experimental group will receive one session in a week that will be comprised of 120 minutes. After completing eight sessions of psycho therapy, post assessment will be conducted to assess the effectiveness.
