Comparison of the effect Jacobson muscle progressive relaxation technique and listening to the sounds of nature on alarm fatigue in nurses of special care units.

Protocol summary

Study aim

Determining the effect of Jacobson muscle progressive relaxation technique and listening to the sounds of nature on alarm fatigue in nurses of special care units of selected hospitals of Shiraz University of Medical Sciences on 2024

Design

After the selection of qualified people, the nurses of the special care department of Namazi, Ali Asghar and Faqihi hospitals will be divided into three groups. One of the groups will be considered as the control group and the other two groups will receive the interventions as intervention groups. The total sample is 96 people.

Settings and conduct

This research is carried out in the special care units of Namazi, Ali Asghar and Faqihi hospitals in Shiraz.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Inclusion criteria for the study 1- Having a bachelor's degree or higher in nursing 2- Working in the Intensive Care Unit 3- Having at least 6 months of work experience 4- Working in rotating shift Exclusion criteria for the study 1- Being absent in one training session 2- Use of Psychiatric drugs 3- Having mental disorders according to the person herself/himself 4- Loss of a close family member in the last 6 months 5- Fixed shift work 6- Individual's request to withdraw from the study

Intervention groups

This research has three groups, two intervention groups perform Jacobson's relaxation techniques and listen to the sounds of nature, and the control group does not perform any intervention and fills out questionnaires.
