The Effect of Multiple Nursing Interventions on the Incidence of Stroke Associated Pneumonia in Patients

Protocol summary

Study aim

Determining the effect of multiple nursing interventions on the incidence of pneumonia -dependent stroke

Design

The randomized clinical trial with intervention and control groups was used for randomization from the randomization site.

Settings and conduct

Department of Neurology, Ali Bin Abitalib Hospital affiliated to Zahedan University of Medical Sciences from the time of patient admission and taking into account the entry criteria in eligible patients for four consecutive days and at least twice a day After the implementation of the mentioned care package, the symptoms including the presence or absence of fever, cough, changes in the number of white blood cells and the final diagnosis of the neurologist will be examined by the relevant tools and finally the occurrence of this complication will be announced by him.

Participants/Inclusion and exclusion criteria

Detecting confirmation of ischemic stroke by a specialist physician, Moderate or intense dysphagia in accordance with the GUSS(Gugging Swallowing Screen) tool;Age older than 18, 24 hours after the onset of ischemic stroke symptoms, National Institutes of Health Stroke Scale(NIHSS) score above 3,Direct acceptance of the patient from the emergency department or the patient's direct referral to the doctor's office;The presence of pneumonia before hospitalization, Patients with liver and kidney failure, Allergies to chlorhexidine, Oral surgery, Patients with immune system suppression, Any malnutrition, Dissatisfaction to participate in the study

Intervention groups

In this study of two tools including GUSS for dysphagia and The International Dysphasia Diet Standardization Initiative(IDDSI) to provide a diet based on the intensity of dysphagia; And the oral care checklist will be used in the patients' patients. The control group will receive the usual sector care.

Randomization description
In this study, patients are divided into two control and intervention groups based on the random assignment of quadruple blocks; Regarding the equal placement of the samples in the two control and intervention groups, a limited randomization method called blocking was used. This method helps this study so that in cases where intermediate analyzes are needed during the sampling process, the number of samples allocated to each of the studied groups is equal. In this study, the size of all blocks is equal. In this study, online randomization was used to generate random sequences. The decision to accept or reject participation in the study is made first and the informed consent form is completed, and then the participants are randomly assigned to each group.

Description

In order to collect the necessary data for the study, three tools and a checklist will be used; With the help of these tools and checklist, patients' conditions are accurately

evaluated and then based on the results, appropriate nursing care is provided for each patient's condition. Tool number one (GUSS) consists of two tests; The test starts with swallowing saliva and then continues with swallowing semi-solid, liquid and solid tissues respectively. Instrument number two (IDDSI) consists of two components: food and beverage component; The nutritional strategy will be chosen by the nurse based on the severity of dysphagia, for example, in moderate dysphagia, feeding will be through a nasogastric tube and the use of pureed food, and in severe dysphagia, the patient will be given fasting and supplements through a nasogastric tube. will be. Oral care will be done using a ten-step checklist. In this study, nursing interventions to affect the occurrence of pneumonia related to ischemic stroke will include the examination of the severity of dysphagia, strategies related to diet and oral care methods in this group of patients after a detailed evaluation of the parameters of the tools and the above checklist. After the implementation of the mentioned care package, in this study, in order to evaluate stroke-related pneumonia, the developed symptoms include the presence or absence of fever, cough and white blood cells equal to and greater than 10×10^9 per liter or white blood cells equal to and smaller than 4×10^9 per liter and the final diagnosis of the neurologist will be examined by the stroke-related pneumonia tool and finally the occurrence of SAP will be announced by him.
