The Efficacy of Adjunctive L-lysine in Patients with Chronic Schizophrenia: A Randomized, Double-Blinded, Placebo-Controlled Trial

Protocol summary

Summary

The objective of this randomized, double-blinded, placebo-controlled study is to test the hypothesis that the addition of L-lysine would improve psychopathology in subjects with schizophrenia treated with Risperidone. 72 patients with chronic DSM-IV-diagnosed schizophrenia will receive Risperidone (6 mg/day) combined with either placebo (N=35) or 6 g/day of L-Lysine (N=35) for 8 weeks. Efficacy will be defined as the change from baseline to endpoint in score on the Positive and Negative Syndrome Scale (PANSS). Side effects will be also evaluated using checklist and Extra-pyramidal Symptoms Rating Scale
